



THE HUSBAND, TWO WIVES, A DAUGHTER AND A LODGER

'Team Morgan' is taking part in the Jane Tomlinson's Leeds 10K on Sunday 21 June, to raise vital funds for Breast Cancer Haven. Team Morgan is made up of Graham Morgan, his current wife Deana, ex-wife Rosemary, Graham and Rosemary's daughter Lucy and 'honorary Morgan' Julie Teale, who is Graham's colleague and is currently lodging with him and Deana.

Breast Cancer Haven in Leeds provides anyone affected by breast cancer across Yorkshire and beyond, a free programme of counselling, complementary therapies, support and information to meet the physical and emotional needs of breast cancer. In Yorkshire alone, 4,000 women are diagnosed with breast cancer every year.

Deana, dance teacher and owner of DM Academy in Bradford, was diagnosed with breast cancer in October 2006. She has been a loyal supporter of Breast Cancer Haven since the appeal was launched to fund a new Haven in Leeds back in June 2007. Deana recognised the benefits that such a service would have had for her, had the Leeds Haven been open during her cancer treatment. In October 2008 the Leeds Haven was officially opened by one of Deana's former pupils, Kimberley Walsh from Girls Aloud.

"The opening of the new Haven was long overdue and we are so fortunate to have one so close to home right here in Yorkshire. I'm really proud to be associated with this amazing place and really excited about wearing my pink Haven vest in my first 10k race since I was diagnosed" says Deana.

It costs on average £1,400 to provide a personalised treatment programme for each Visitor coming to our Havens. Our specialist services are known to make a huge difference to people's lives at what is often the most difficult time. Team Morgan, along with the other 22 Breast Cancer Haven runners, is hoping to raise £4,000, which would mean more women with breast cancer are supported by our expert therapists and counsellors.

Breast Cancer Haven receives no government funding and relies entirely on charitable donations and fundraising events to meet all our costs. "Graham has certainly got his work cut out running with such a mix of Morgans, but with Deana's help we're hoping they'll all cross the finish as one big happy – and dancing - family!" comments Jane King, Yorkshire Fundraising Executive. "The money 'Team Morgan' raises will directly support and help anyone dealing with breast cancer who visits the Haven".
